

Michael Muir

Born in Scotland and having spent his childhood in Southeast Asia, Michael Muir (b.1975) is a contemporary artist based in Sydney, Australia. Honing his studio skills through formal studies in painting and design, Muir has departed from traditional en plein-air painting to describe more ambiguous visual puzzles derived from the urban landscape.



Muir's paintings portray picturesque

scenescapes using solid colour blocks and a consistently muted colour palette. His background in graphic art and design equips him with a distinctive perspective on geometry, landscape, and architecture, profoundly shaping his overall artistic practice. Empirically influenced by his surroundings, Muir depicts simplistic contemporary Australian landscapes, coalescing urban constructions with natural formations. His convivial solidity and dream-like compositions are achieved by the application of paint through a palette knife, employing a textural vibrancy that oscillates between memory and reality.

Muir's work employs autobiographical referencing, regarding his childhood, children, multicultural background and travels. Enacting a generational connectivity while incorporating personal resonance, Muir's compositions embody a sentimentality that operates on a universal and individual scale, leaving the viewer with visual documentation of his artificially constructed memories. Verging the borders of figuration and abstraction, Muir playfully harnesses mundane scenes and imbues them with an atmospheric warmth, leaving his audience in a state of comfort and familiarity in scenes that are virtually unknown to them.

"I realised over time, that my approach to finding subject matter relates to my personal experience of shifting homes and countries at a young age. There is a mix of excitement and trepidation when you arrive at a new place, and a natural instinct to seek out what is familiar and inviting within a new environment. When I travel now, I often make quick sketches, and gouache paintings utilising a camera and write ideas about feelings and spontaneous thoughts. Looking for a sense of vibrancy and belonging within the surroundings. When I bring these working ideas and studies back to the studio and start working on a larger scale, I slowly unravel the interplay of colour, composition, and form. The paintings purposely blend truth and fiction but also connect with early personal memories that set me on a path to looking at the world around me."

Muir was the winner of the Mosman Art Prize 2014 and has been a finalist in several awards over the past decade including the Wynne, Sulman, and Fleurieu Art Prizes. His work is represented in Australia's Artbank Collection, Parliament House Art Collection, and private collections throughout Australia and internationally.
